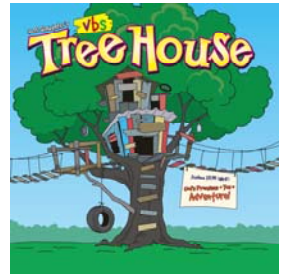
Trentham Hall Closure
