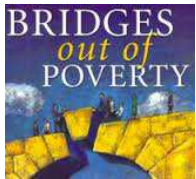
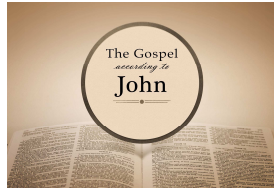


## Refreshment and Renewal During Lent
