Sunday, July 22-29

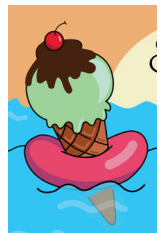

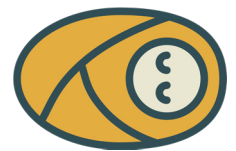
July 4: Offices closed, no Wednesday activities, and no Sanctuary Choir Practice
